(These questions were from the last page of the previous bible study from the first part of Acts in which we ran out of time.)

Sometimes it seems that the miracles and signs done in Acts were more effective in people believing in Jesus then when Jesus did them, is that the case and why? (ex Acts 9:40-42)

In Acts 10 why did Peter see the vision three times?

How does Acts 10:34-35 echo and confirm what we saw in Acts 2?

Why did the church in Jerusalem give Peter a hard time in Acts 11:3?

In Antioch is where followers of Jesus were first called Christians, what does that term mean? Acts 11:26

In Acts 12:2 James the brother of John is put to death, who then is Peter talking about in Acts 12:17?

What does the name Barnabas mean?

Who is the Mark mentioned in Acts 13?

Why did Paul and Barnabas shake the dust off their feet in Acts 13:51?

In Lystra how could the crowd turn so quickly from believing they were gods to trying to kill them? Acts 14:19-20

If you were Paul and Barnabas how would you feel like the ministry is going for them?

What is the shift that takes place from Acts 1-12 to 13-28?

How does verse 14:22 sit with many in the church today?

What was the issue in Chapter 15 that caused the first “church business” meeting?

In the end why are only three things listed that the Gentiles should stay away from? What about following the ten commandments?

What sign accompanied Paul as he preached the good news to the Gentiles showing God’s approval?

**What was the issue that caused Barnabus and Paul to split ways?
Acts 15:37-40**

In Acts 16 we meet Timothy. Why was he circumcised if it no longer held value any longer?

Why is there a shift in pronoun use moving forward in 16:10 from “they and them” to “we and us?”

In chapter 16 why would the officials be alarmed to hear that Paul was a Roman citizen? How did he use that to his advantage? Look at 22:25-29

Paul says in chapter 17 that God has done certain things that causes us to reach out to him; what has He done in your life that has made you reach out to Him?

Compare the message Pauls receives from the holy Spirit in 20:23,18:9-10 and in 9:16. Does the warning deter Paul or even slow him down once arrested?

Did Paul disobey the Spirit in 21:4?

Paul quotes Jesus and says it is more blessed to give than to receive, how has this played out in your life? Is it true? Acts 20:35

In Acts 21:20-26 why did Paul agree to paying for and go through the purification requirements back in Jerusalem?

In Chapter 24, what did Paul do during the 2 years he was held in Caesarea? Acts 24:27

Why was Festus hesitant to send Paul on to Rome?

Where else have we seen the quote in Acts 28:26-27?

Why does the book end so abruptly?
