In verse 13 and 14 Paul mentions two wonderful truths that the Holy Spirit fulfills for us, what are they and what do they mean?

What difference do you think praying verses 17-19 could make in your own life and in the life of the church?

2:2 Who is the ruler of the kingdom of air? Does it surprise you that they are ruling?

Verses 8-10 of chapter 2 are powerful verses that remind us that it is by grace through faith that we are saved, not by our works. So why do any “works” at all if it does not save us?

What covenant is Paul referring to in Eph 2:12?

Who are the people who are far away and those who are close Eph 2:17

Why does Paul want his readers to grasp the love of God in 3:17-19?

How can we live a life worthy of our calling? 4:1

What is your understanding of verses 4:7-10?

When will we no longer be tossed around like infants? 4:17

How are we to speak to each other? 4:15 What is the difficulty in doing this?

In 4:26 Paul talks about anger. Is anger a sin? Why should we not let the sun go down while we are angry? Does anger give the devil a foothold?

4:29 What is the unwholesome talk that Paul refers to? Is it the good natured ribbing we give one another? Did Paul let unwholesome talk come out of his mouth? Look at Gal 5:12; 2 Cor 11:5,14,15.

How do we grieve the Holy Spirit 4:30?

How could 5:1-2 be your mantra?

In 5:22-30 why does Paul give so much more advice to men than the women? What is the difference between the advice he gives to husbands and wives?

In the end what advice does Paul give to the woman and then the man in verse 33? What do you think about that advice?

Is 6:1-3 a promise, like a guarantee?

What does it mean to exasperate your children in 6:4?

Which part of the armor is easiest/hardest for you to put on? Who does Paul remind us that our battle is against?

This is a trick question but could be seen as the last piece of the armor?
