From Luke 6:9 How would you have answered Jesus? If the answer would have been "to do good, to save life," how does the Sabbath then differentiate from any other day? How can we honor the Sabbath today?

What do you notice in Luke's Beatitudes (Luke 6:20-26) compared to Matthew's? Whose do you relate to more?

Jesus says no good tree bears bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. Each tree is recognized by its own fruit. (Luke 6:43-45) How do you respond to people who seem to be a mixed bag of both good and bad fruit like the disciples?

What do you think, did Jesus go with the Centurion because he deserved to have his servant healed (Luke 7:4)?

From Luke 7:16 how does the people's rejoicing match up with the mission of Jesus?

In Luke 8 47 Jesus whoever has been forgiven little loves little- do you think that those who have been forgiven much love much, or struggle believing that they are really forgiven? What is the reason for her forgiveness of sins- her love or her faith?

In chapter 8 Luke mentions several women who accompanied the disciples and Jesus, why would Luke remember these women in his story?

The demon possessed man who was cured by Jesus; how is his mission also our mission?

Why could the disciples not drive the demon out of the child in Luke 9:37-42?

James and John wanted to bring fire down from heaven on a town in Samara for opposing Jesus's visit Luke 9:54, what does it reveal about their heart? Compare their thoughts to Jesus' instruction in Luke 9:3-5 and Luke 19:12.

**Compare and contrast the words of Jesus in Luke 11:23 and Luke 9:49-50.
Whoever is not with me is against me
For whoever is not against you is for you**

Luke 11:52 how had the experts in the law taken away the key to knowledge?

What is the point of the shrew manager in Luke 16?

How have we seen Jesus' words in Luke 16:31 be true throughout the scripture?

Why did Jesus weep over Jerusalem in Luke 19:41?

What is the meaning of Luke 20:17? Who is the stone that builders rejected? Whether people fall on it or it falls on them, are all people hurt?

In Luke 21:18 Jesus says to the disciples not to worry because “not a hair on their head will perish. Stand firm, and you will win life”, was Jesus wrong? Most of the disciples were martyred.

In Luke 22 in the midst of their conversation Jesus tells them they are going to need swords, and the disciples say they have two, then Jesus tells them, “That’s enough.” Later when Jesus is arrested he is frustrated that one of the disciples cuts the ear off the guard; why does Jesus tell them to get swords if he doesn’t want them to use them?

When Jesus is arrested he says this is the hour when darkness reigns, why? Luke 22:53

Why did the men not believe the women after their experience at the tomb? Luke 24:11

What were the men on the road hoping that Jesus was? And was he what they were hoping? Luke 24:21

How does Luke end like he started?
