How does this fit with how he ends this chapter at verse 16?

Paul says he gave them milk not solid food because they were not ready in 3:2, what would be the solid food that Paul would like to give them?

In 3:9 what is your purpose in God's building, his field, how are you co-working with God?

3:16 how are we God's temple?

4:10 Paul says that he is a fool for Christ. What does that mean and are you willing to be as well?

At the end of chapter 4 Paul says for the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power? What does he mean by this?

What is the problem in chapter 5? What does Paul say do do about it? What does he hope will happen?

What do you think of Paul's advice in 5:9-11? Is it possible?

In the first half of Chapter 6, why does Paul warn believers from taking each other to court? Would you rather be wronged?

Paul says in verse 3 that we will judge the Angels, what are your thoughts on that?

The last half of chapter 6 Paul talks about why is sexually immorality is harmful to believers. What is your definition of sexually immorality and why should believers abstain from it if as he says in verse 12 "I have the right to do anything?"

What is Paul's sexual intimacy marital advice in Chapter 7?

Why is it good for the unmarried to stay unmarried? Is it necessary?
